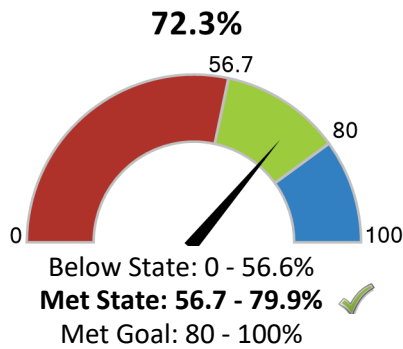
## School Highlights Reported by the District

- Many clubs, activities, and athletics are available for students after the academic day.

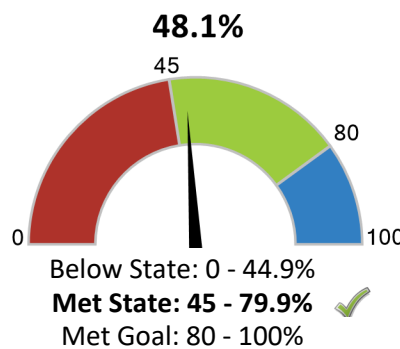

#### English Language Arts



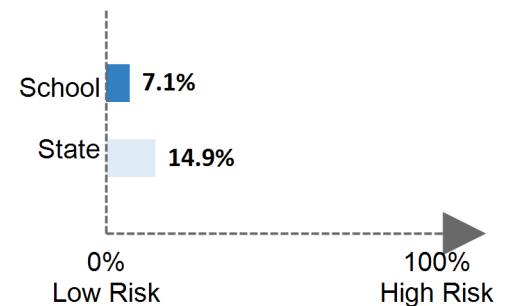

Students that were absent for 10% or more of days enrolled

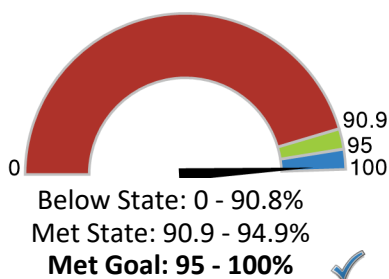
#### Chronic Absenteeism
