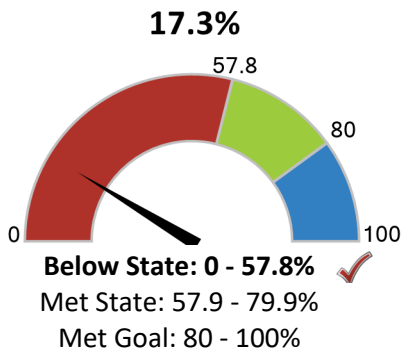
School Highlights Reported by the District

- Throughout the school year Lincoln High School students can be seen all throughout Jersey City volunteering in various community service projects, walking for causes such as cancer awareness, raising

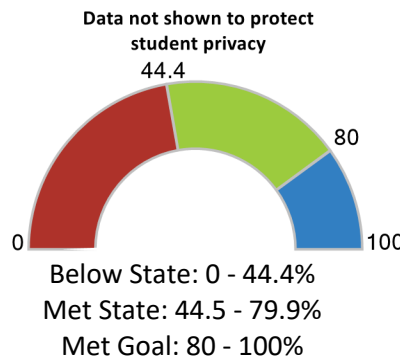
How did students perform on assessments?

English Language Arts



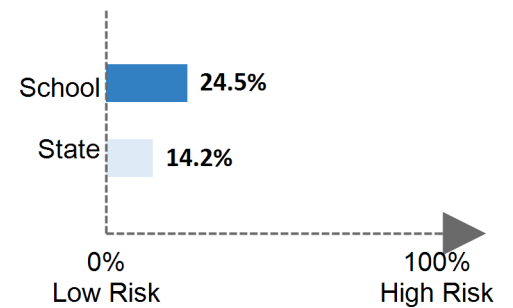
Math

Students that were absent for 10% or more of days enrolled

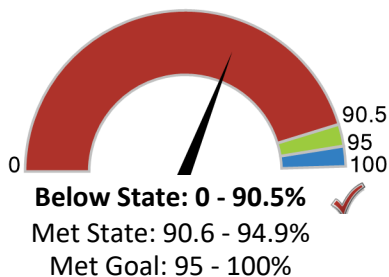
Chronic Absenteeism
